

FY26 PROGRAM REPORT



ANNA'S HOUSE

CATHOLIC CHARITIES IN ACTION

SUMMARY

In FY26, Anna's House served 97 of Harford County's most vulnerable individuals, including 45 children. Through intensive case management, individualized goal planning, and targeted life skills education, participants increased earned income, secured mainstream benefits, improved financial literacy, and obtained employment. During the year, the program rapidly rehoused 32 individuals and provided ongoing housing stability for 31 individuals experiencing chronic homelessness.

To strengthen participant outcomes, Anna's House expanded partnerships with Aberdeen Proving Ground Federal Credit Union, Solutions 4 You, Priority One Temp Agency, and the Harford County Health Department. These collaborations enhanced the program's life skills curriculum by providing financial literacy, nutrition education, job readiness training, and employment support. As a result, participants obtained and maintained employment, secured transportation, strengthened financial stability, and reconnected with supportive family members.

SERVICES PROVIDED

- Emergency shelter for families experiencing homelessness
- Transitional housing for women and children fleeing domestic violence
- Rapid Re-housing
- Lifeskills classes
- Permanent Supportive Housing for individuals with disabilities who are chronically homeless
- Comprehensive case management and goal setting for all participants
