SUMMARY

During the 2026 fiscal year, Community Housing programs continued its partnership with Heaven on Earth Now which provides a monthly life-skills curriculum for families and single men. The service is designed to address areas of skill development such as safety, health care, wellness and home cleanliness. Clients benefit significantly from this added support. The program provides a monthly life-skills toolkit box that includes educational materials, supplies and wellness psycho-educational information.

Additionally, the Community Housing programs identified 13 single men from Project Reach who began to infuse workforce development support services through the employment readiness program at Our Daily Bread Employment Center. They will engage in services to support job readiness with the goal of gaining employment.

- Permanent housing for individuals and families
- Case management support
- Connection to community resources
- Transportation assistance
- Life skills, substance use support, and workshops
- Workforce development resources
