MY SISTER'S PLACE WOMEN'S CENTER

CATHOLIC CHARITIES IN ACTION

SUMMARY

A major FY26 achievement was partnering with Catholic Charities' Weinberg Housing and Resource Center (WHRC) to provide overnight shelter for My Sister's Place Women's Center (MSPWC) clients who might otherwise sleep in the alley outside the center. Each morning, a bus from WHRC drops off MSPWC clients for daily services, meals, and access to mental health supports. Each afternoon, a bus picks up the My Sister's Place clients at 4 p.m. and drops them off at WHRC for the evening. Each day, twenty clients have benefited from this partnership.

Another FY26 goal has been to increase client participation in workshops. By June 2026, average workshop attendance had reached 18 participants. Many staff-led workshops have also helped reduce barriers and built increased trust between clients and staff.

SERVICES PROVIDED

- Meal services (3 meals a day, 7 days a week)
- Laundry services
- Shower services
- Mail services
- Life Skills workshops
- Assistance with obtaining IDs, birth certificates, Social Security cards
- Links to Temporary Cash Assistance (TCA) and Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Housing navigation services
- Job readiness programs
- Eviction prevention support
- Travelers aid
