

FY26 PROGRAM REPORT



CATHOLIC CHARITIES SENIOR COMMUNITIES

SUMMARY

Catholic Charities Senior Communities owns and operates 24 supportive, affordable apartment communities in Baltimore City, Baltimore, Anne Arundel, Garrett, and Harford Counties, including nearly 1,800 units of efficiency, one- and two-bedroom apartments.

FY26 brought much success to Senior Communities. We maintained a 96% occupancy, serving 1,995 residents and 178 Caring Home Services participants. More than 1,802 applicants are on our waiting list for housing and services. Our service coordination team assisted residents with 52,000 individual services, including benefit programs, insurance and healthcare services, food security, home management and isolation prevention. Two Senior Communities received \$317,000 for energy efficiency upgrades.

SERVICES PROVIDED

- The Caring Home Services (CHS) Program, available at select communities, offers home management services to support safely aging in place. Services vary by location and include weekly housekeeping, laundry, personal services, and daily meals served in a group setting.
- Residents enjoy a variety of on-site features such as laundry rooms, computer centers, wellness suites, libraries, dining rooms and outdoor seating areas.
- Health care services available to residents may include podiatry and monthly blood pressure checks.
- Resident service coordinators are available at all communities to assist residents in accessing various resources and benefits to help with finances, health care and transportation, to name a few.
