SUMMARY

Despite referral/census challenges (due to external factors) at Villa Maria School, particularly during the first half of the FY, we were able to make up ground in the second half of the year and improve academic programming by building competence among teachers through the Personal Learning Community (PLC) process, utilizing teachers' expertise in a peer learning community to aid one another. We also built capacity in better serving students on the Autism Spectrum.

At St. Vincent's Villa, we expanded and strengthened our resources/services to families through our well-attended Trauma-Informed Classes and reintroduction of in-person family support group meetings. We also secured contributions to fund clinical intern stipends.

Two key accomplishments:

- 1) Became recertified as a CARE Agency, an evidence-based, trauma-informed approach to care through Cornell University
- 2) Successfully completed re-licensure for our Diagnostic Program and increased the per diem rate we receive through the State of Maryland.
