SUMMARY

In FY26, Weinberg Housing Resource Center (WHRC) established a great partnership with Villa Maria Behavioral Health to provide onsite support services. This includes a trained mental health therapist facilitating groups that cover a variety of topics pertaining to health and wellness. Individual therapy is provided to those in crisis or in need of general support on a voluntary basis. A Life Skills and Wellness position was created in FY26. As a result, daily and weekly programming has increased drastically as program participants now have the chance to attend groups that cover numerous topics such as housing readiness sessions, move-out preparation, financial literacy, coping with anxiety, anger management, crochet groups, yoga, contemplating sobriety, entertainment, and much more. The program participants can look forward to daily, weekly, and monthly structure and positive activities to focus on during their shelter stay.
